

Latte Quilt Fabrics

Buy all your fabrics with the yardage listed at the same time if possible. It may not be available in a couple months when you need more. If needed you could purchase Fabric B for the sashing, binding and borders later as you will not need these until the last few months of the class. The backing can be an exception; this could be purchased later if you are unsure as to what you will be using for backing. Fabric B, the satin, is broken into three pieces because it's easier to cut this way, but it is the same fabric.

Keep in mind that the yardages listed are what you need for the quilt. If you will be wanting pillow shams, throw pillows, a bedskirt or other accessories, you may want to purchase extra fabric.

Fabric A - muslin (blocks) - 45" wide, 4 yds. or 108" wide, 2 yds.

This is used for eight blocks and parts of the center medallion. If you are using the Latte colors, this needs to be unbleached muslin, but you could also substitute a marbled, tone on tone or frosted cotton fabric instead of muslin.

Fabric B - satin (blocks) - 45" wide, 5 yds. or 60" wide, 3 ½ yds.

This is for eight blocks, the center medallion and the squares in the border with the right and wrong sides of the fabric being used. This needs to be a polyester satin that has quite a bit of body to it with a small amount of sheen. It will need to hold a large amount of embroidery designs, decorative stitches and quilting, so it needs to be a medium-heavyweight satin to hold the stitches. It also needs to be a washable polyester satin as there will be marked lines to wash out.

Fabric B - satin (sashing & binding) - 45" or 60" wide, 2 ½ yds.

This is for the sashing and binding with the right side of the fabric being used. This needs to be a polyester satin that has quite a bit of body to it with a small amount of sheen. It also needs to be a washable polyester satin as there will be marked lines to wash out.

Fabric B - satin (outside borders) - 45" wide, 3 ¾ yds. or 60" wide, 2 ½ yds.

This is for the outside borders with the wrong side of the fabric being used. This needs to be a polyester satin that has quite a bit of body to it with a small amount of sheen. It will need to hold a large amount of quilting, so it needs to be a medium-heavyweight satin to hold the stitches. It also needs to be a washable polyester satin as there will be marked lines to wash out.

Fabric C - backing - 45" wide, Queen - 9 yds. / King - 9 ¾ yds. or
108" wide, Queen - 3 yds. / King - 4 yds.

The backing usually is a muslin or cotton. Satin has a smoother finish and tends to fall of the bed easier than a cotton.

Quilt Sizes -

Queen Size Quilt - 96 ½" square

King Size Quilt - 104 ½" square

Keep in mind these sizes can be changed by the outside sashing and borders if needed. The yardages listed above will be enough for a queen or king size quilt made in the above sizes.
